REPORT

The Govt. of Delhi is receiving supplies of Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO), mainly from M/s Linde India Ltd. on payment through Indian Railways. However, there are other suppliers/manufacturers also which are providing LMO to Delhi free of cost, those are termed as "Special Supplies" through Indian Railways.

The Nodal Officers were deputed at the Railway Stations to lift such supplies of LMO and they get it decanted into the Tankers. These Tankers there after supply the LMO through DTC to various hospitals/health centres/ refillers etc. This transmission of LMO, from container to tanker & tanker to hospital/refillers etc. leads to certain loss of LMO.

The details of all these supplies of LMO from M/s Linde and other special suppliers received in Delhi upto 11th May 2021 and distributed through DTC to various hospitals/health centres/refillers etc. are as under:
