A State Level Expert Committee, as detailed below, is hereby constituted to devise the management strategy for mitigation and management of third wave of COVID-19 cases in Delhi.

The Committee shall also be empowered to co-opt additional members for implementing its mandate. Dr. Ashish Chandra Verma, IAS, Pr. Secretary (H&FW) and Shri Sanjeev Khirwar, IAS, Divisional Commissioner cum Pr. Secretary (Revenue), are co-opted as permanent members.

The mandate of the committee will be as follows:-

- 1. Devise a plan for mitigating the impact of the third wave and preparation required for the specialized needs of children of the city.
- 2. To analyse the data trends, experiences of other cities across the globe and conduct modeling exercises to foresee and predict the onset of such waves and the changing/mutating character of the virus.
- 3. Prepare a Graded Response Action Plan cased on Positivity Rate indicator
- 4. Devise clear guidelines on when to announce lockdown and to what degree or extent. For example X cases **and** y+ positivity rate for z days means announce strict lockdown with the following guidelines, and similarly for limited lockdown etc.
- 5. Prepare a plan of action for increasing and activating hospital infrastructure (isolation beds, oxygen beds, ICU beds, ventilators), essential drugs, oxygen

supply, and other crucial items based on the positivity rate indicator. The committee will identify in advance which hospitals in which areas will get activated at different stages as cases rise in the city. For example, there must be a clear plan at 5/10/15/20/25/30% positivity rate, which facilities will have how many beds allocated, which are the new facilities being added in the city as the percentage goes up along with allied components required to operate these facilities. The plan should be prepared in such a manner that each stage of the plan can be activated within a short time frame.

6. Prepare a plan for deployment of manpower, equipment and other resources in a graded manner based on 5.
