- Chandigarh, April 1- Haryana Chief Secretary, Mrs. Keshni Anand Arora has directed that counselors or community group leaders of the various community should be engaged to counsel the migrants living in the Relief Camps across the State.
- She said that the officers to explore the possibility of engaging private counselors and physiatrist. She said that all the Deputy Commissioners should ensure that a nodal



officer in each district should be appointed to ensure the engagement of these counselors.

- The Chief Secretary was presiding over the meeting of the Crisis Coordination Committee meeting through video conferencing here today.
- She also directed that the police officers should ensure that the anxiety of migrant labourers living in various Relief Camps should be done in a humane manner. She said that the possibility of installing a TV in these Relief camps should also be ensured and it should further be ensured that social distancing in these camps is maintained.
- She said that all the Municipal Committees, Numberdars, Sarpanches, Panches, Irrigation department teams, to keep a close vigil on the movement o the migrant labourers and apart from this the registration of each migrant labourers should be done with the complete details of their Aadhar number, residence address and contact numbers.
- She directed that work tracking and tracing of every person entering the State from neighbouring States should be intensified. Apart from this, the identification of foreign returnees should also be intensified.
- The Chief Secretary further shared that directions should be issued that the banks across the State should remain open and along with this it should also be ensured that maximum ATMs should remain open to avoid the rush. She said that all the Deputy Commissioners would ensure the benefits being given of various schemes should be done in a staggered manner and there should not be any chaos in the banks and ATMs. She said that it should also be ensured that people do not visit the banks in large numbers.
- The Chief Secretary further directed that as per the guidelines, certain parameters have been set for the dedicated COVID hospitals, therefore all the health and the medical education officers should ensure that the parameters are being followed thoroughly.
- She further directed that the availability of oxygen cylinders and adequate number of ventilators should also be ensured in every hospital across the State. She directed that the doctors, health workers and paramedical staff should be motivated and convinced that the State



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cares for their safety and with this, the availability of necessary equipment like PPE kits, gloves; sanitizer and N-95 masks, etc for them should be ensured.

- Talking about the scenario of 'False news', the Chief Secretary said that IEC activities should be intensified in every district and every Deputy Commissioners along with the DPROS should counter the rumour mongering. She said that action should be taken against those spreading 'False News'.
- She further directed that the supply chain of essential commodities should also be ensured and the production of all the necessary goods and products should not be stopped. Apart from this, the movement of essential commodities coming from neighbouring states should also be done smoothly. The availability of stocks in the markets should also be ensured so that people of the State do not face any problem, the Chief Secretary added.
- She shared the cleanliness of Relief camps, thermal checking of migrants living there and the volunteers and authorities distributing food should be done

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
