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## Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.




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### **Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:**

- **Treated & Cured:** Seven Hundred Twenty Four (724) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 47, Bageshwar– 07, Chamoli– 04, Champawat– 85, Dehradun– 231, Haridwar– 49, Nainital– 139, Pauri– 02, Pithoragarh– 06, Rudraprayag– 07, Tehri– 13, U.S. Nagar– 33 & Uttarkashi– 101).
- **Death:** Nine (09) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
  - 1. A 24 year old Female expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, COVID Pneumonia & Fungal Pneumonia.
  - 2. A 60 year old Male expired in Synergy Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun due to Cardiac Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Septic Shock.
  - 3. A 51 year old Male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Severe COVID & Acute Kidney Injury.
  - 4. A 55 year old Male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehardun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonia, Type 1 Respirtaory Failure & Acute Kidney Injury.
  - 5. A 75 year old Female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Severe Metabolic Acidosis & Shock.
  - 6. A 69 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
  - 7. A 45 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Septicemia, Acute Kidney Injury & Septic Shock
  - 8. A 67 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Type 1 Respiratory Failure.
  - 9. A 55 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis & Septicemia.


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### **Preventive measures**
