With reference to the above and due to a steep rise in Covid Cases in the State of Goa, there is a need to reactivate a public awareness campaign to influence public behavior on wearing masks, social distancing and maintaining hand hygiene. Further, there is also a need to create public awareness on the ongoing Covid vaccination drive being conducted by the Government.

In view of the above, you are required to display banners /posters at entry gates of your Head/ Sub Offices for creating awareness on Covid and also on Covid vaccinations (copies enclosed). Further, the persons who are vaccinated from various departments, if any, may share their experience and encourage their fellow colleagues and staff on the importance of vaccination to curtail the spread of this contagious virus.

The above directions are to be conveyed to all officials of your departments and banners/posters in public areas under your jurisdiction for effective implementation in order to curb the spread of the pandemic, under intimation to this office. Also, Covid appropriate behavior i.e. wearing masks, social distancing and maintaining hand hygiene and guidelines issued by the MHA from time to time and shall be strictly followed at all Government Departments and offices and public areas under your jurisdiction. Violations, if any, shall be viewed strictly and action taken accordingly.

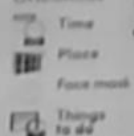


Wait for a phone call or letter from your GP

Make a note of when and where to go



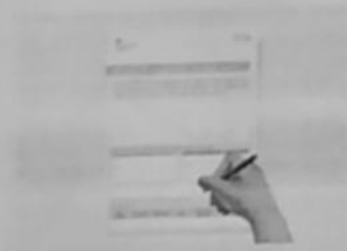
It may be at hospital, GP, a pharmacy or a Vaccination Centre

Talk about any worries or concerns



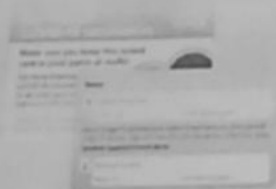
Sign the consent form if you agree to be vaccinated

Getting vaccinated can help prevent getting sick with COVID-19.



People who have already gotten sick with COVID-19 may still benefit from getting vaccinated.



COVID-19 vaccines cannot give you COVID-19.



COVID-19 vaccines will not cause you to test positive on COVID-19 viral tests.*



COVID-19 vaccines do not change or interact with your DNA in any way.



There is currently no evidence that COVID-19 vaccines cause any problems with pregnancy or fertility.

All COVID-19 vaccines have to undergo rigorous testing as follows:

3 phases of clinical trials

Approval process of **Stringent Regulatory Authorities**

National drug regulation authority which is considered by the WHO to apply stringent standards for quality, safety and efficacy in its process of regulatory review of drugs and vaccines for marketing authorisation.



COVID-19 VACCINATION SAVES LIVES
Vaccination **reduces the risks** of infection, especially severe infection that leads to hospitalisation.



This will help keep our hospitals and healthcare facilities from being overwhelmed.

Vaccinated people are probably **less likely to transmit** COVID-19

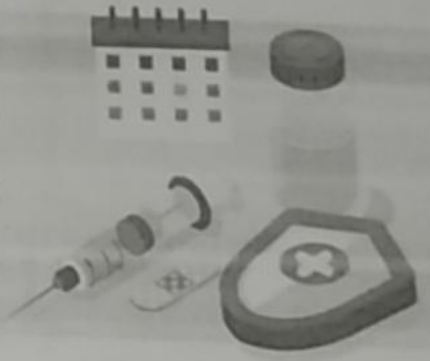
Enough vaccinated people can **reduce the spread.**

COVID-19 vaccines help your body develop immunity and are effective at preventing the disease.



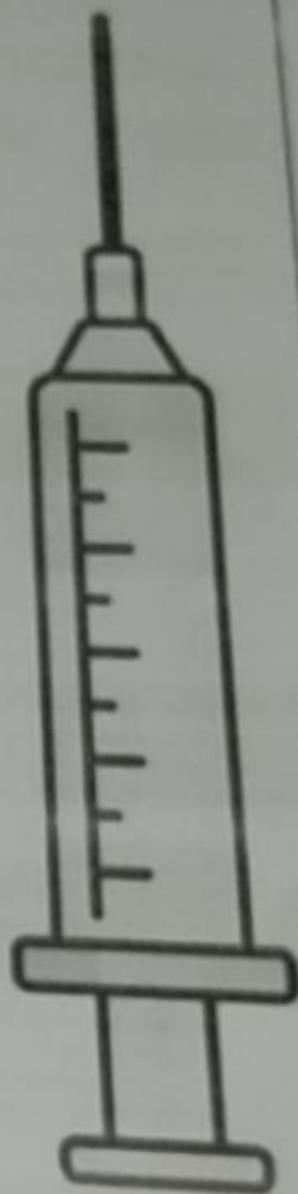
IT'S SAFER THAN GETTING THE DISEASE.
