Media Bulletin on COVID-19, Dated- 24/05/2021

World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as Pandemic. Till now it has affected 216 countries/areas/territories, infected 16,63,46,635 people and caused 34,49,117 deaths. Most severely affected countries are the United States of America, India, Brazil, France, Turkey, Russian Federation etc. Till date in India, it has infected 2,67,52,447 people including 3,03,720 deaths.

In order to contain the spread of the virus, Haryana Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease.

- ❖ The scheme initiated from May 15, 2021
- ❖ The villages with high COVID load are taken up on priority
- ❖ Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) is the main stay to detect COVID cases
- ❖ Screening of the rural population carried out by Village Health Screening Teams
- ❖ The suspected cases are checked by Village Headquarter Teams and tested for COVID by Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) Teams
- ❖ Trainings are being imparted to the healthcare workers as well as non-health department personnel through online sessions in which about 31350 participants have logged in and trained till date while 250 health care professionals have logged in the training initiated from today.

Major Activities undertaken by the State of Haryana to control the spread of COVID-19

- Department of Health fixed the per day upper cap of COVID treatment charges in all private hospitals through order dated 25.06.2020. The rates for isolation beds (Rs. 8, 000 per day for Non- NABH Hospitals, Rs. 10, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals), ICU Beds without Ventilators (Rs. 13, 000 per day for Non-NABH Hospitals, Rs. 15, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals), ICU Beds with Ventilators (Rs. 15, 000 per day for Non- NABH Hospitals, Rs. 18, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals).
- State Government has fixed the Rates/ Charges for different type of COVID 19 testing as below:-
 1. CBNAAT testing- 2400/-.
 2. True NAT Testing- 1250/-
 3. Samples collected at private hospitals/ labs and their designated collection centers - 450/-
 4. Samples collected through home visits - 699/-
 5. Rapid Antigen Testing-500/-
 6. IgG based ELISA Testing-250/-
- Total 6945 number of Plasma Units collected from COVID 19 recovered patients till date and 4674 COVID 19 Patients given Plasma Therapy treatment till date.
- Control Room –cum- Helpline of 30 lines has been made operational at Panchkula. Services of tele-medicines are being provided through helpline. The helpline nos. are 8558893911, 1075 and 108 (Ambulance Services) available for 24 X 7.
- The State Government notified ‘The Haryana Government Epidemic, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020’ under the Epidemic Disease Act 1897 on 11th March 2020.

Hospital, Kurukshetra (2500 sample per day), AAL Research and Solution Pvt. Ltd., Panchkula (1000 sample per day), Spice Healthcare Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram (2000 sample per day), Hindustan Wellness Lab, Gurugram (5000 sample per day), FICCI Research and Analysis Centre, New Delhi (700 sample per day), CNC Pathlab Jhandewalla, Delhi (1000 sample per day), NC Medical College, Israna, Paniath (400 sample per day), World Medical College (500 sample per day), AL FALAH Medical College Faridabad (400 sample per day) and Genestrings Diagnostic Centre, Delhi (3000 sample per day) are doing test for COVID-19.

- More than 84.62 lac persons have already downloaded Aarogya Setu App in Haryana.
- More than 50 Mobile Health Teams have already been formed to check health status regarding SARI, ILI etc.
- Haryana has 41, 707 bedded quarantine facilities in Dedicated COVID Care Centers and 13,731 Beds are available in Dedicated COVID Hospitals and in Dedicated COVID Health Centers.
- Department of Ayush has distributed immunity boosting medicines to more than 12.19 lac persons in containment zones.
- A total no. of 102 FIRs have been registered against 127 accused persons and 55 arrests have been for spreading fake news/rumors on WhatsApp and social media.
- A total no. of 21 FIRs have been registered against 92 known accused persons/ various unknown persons and 28 arrests have been for attacking on religious minorities.
