World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as Pandemic. Till now it has affected 216 countries/areas/territories, infected 16,74,23,479 people and caused 34,80,480 deaths. Most severely affected countries are the United States of America, India, Brazil, France, Turkey, Russian Federation etc. Till date in India, it has infected 2,71,57,795 people including 3,11,388 deaths.

In order to contain the spread of the virus, Haryana Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease.

- The suspected cases are checked by Village Headquarter Teams and tested for COVID by Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) Teams
- Trainings are being imparted to the healthcare workers as well as non-health department personnel through online sessions in which about 35076 participants have logged in and trained till date while 400 health care professionals have logged in the training initiated from today.

Major Activities undertaken by the State of Haryana to control the spread of COVID-19

- Department of Health fixed the per day upper cap of COVID treatment charges in all private hospitals through order dated 25.06.2020. The rates for isolation beds (Rs. 8, 000 per day for Non-NABH Hospitals, Rs. 10, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals), ICU Beds without Ventilators (Rs. 13, 000 per day for Non-NABH Hospitals, Rs. 15, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals), ICU Beds with Ventilators (Rs. 15, 000 per day for Non-NABH Hospitals, Rs. 18, 000 per day for JCI/ NABH Hospitals).

- Department of Ayush has distributed immunity boosting medicines to more than 12.19 lac persons in containment zones
- A total no. of 102FIRs have been registered against 127accused persons and 55 arrests have been for spreading fake news/rumors on WhatsApp and social media.
- A total no. of 21FIRs have been registered against 92 known accused persons/ various unknown persons and 28 arrests have been for attacking on religious minorities.
