NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 13/04/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **213 Countries** / **Territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 13th April 2020, Cumulatively 247 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 6 Deaths & 60 Discharges"

Out of remaining 181 cases, 177 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 4 *in ICU* (P43, P101, P108-K & P195).

15 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 12.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 13.04.2020 5:00 PM.

1	Hon'ble Chief Minister, Government of Karnataka has launched <i>CORONA Helpdesk</i> in partnership with WhatsApp, for latest updates and facts on COVID-19. 2	Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Department of Health & Family Welfare and Medical Education has issued a circular vide No.HFW 100 ACS 2020 dated 11.04.2020 regarding Definition of Hotspot, Cluster and Containment Zone for Karnataka.
3	Commissioner, BBMP has ordered (No.PRS(4)/PR/19/2020-2021 dated 12.04.2020) all Private Health Care Facilities <i>must not</i> deny Essential and Critical Emergency Services to any patients by the Health Care Provider citing ongoing situation of COVID-19. All such patients must be promptly attended and provided with necessary consultation and treatment.
4	In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 124 people have been screened on 12.04.2020 and till on date 3255 people have been screened.
5	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 4 persons in Institutions on 12.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 466 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
6	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 966 sessions were held on 12.04.2020 and so far 33,923 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 12.04.2020 calls **6,008** have been received and around 7,496 calls have out gone along with 4 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call 104 – Arogya Sahayavani, Health Helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
