NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 18/04/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **213 Countries / Territories including** India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th
March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 18th April 2020, Cumulatively 384 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 14 Deaths & 104 Discharges"

Out of remaining **266** cases, **263** COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman, P-176) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **3 in ICU** (P101, P281 & P349).

25 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 17.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 18.04.2020, 5:00 PM.

Programmatic Updates

1	Chief Minister of Karnataka through his letter appreciated all ministers, State and district level officers, NGOs and Donors and especially staff from Department of Health, Police and District Corporation for their effort and contribution towards containment of COVID-19 in Karnataka, and requested all elected members/Ministers to ensure effective implementation of Lock Down, Social distance is been maintained in public during day to day activities and all government supply reaches to the needy. (Ref. No. CM/PS/713/2020 Dated: 17/04/2020).
2	In order to ensure effective tracking of all COVID possible cases in the state, Chief Secretary to the Govt. Karnataka has instructed all Non Covid Districts to conduct lab testing for all ILI (Influenza Like Illness) and SARI (Sevier acute respiratory Illness) cases in their Districts, in this regards it is said to send at least 50 samples per day to the respective COVID-19 labs in their Districts. (Ref. No. 3/5/220 Dated 17.04.2020)
3	Chief Secretary to the Govt. Karnataka has issued circular on revised definition of Containment Zone, Cluster and their management S.OP for Karnataka. (Ref. No. HFW 109 ACS 2020 Dated: 17-04-2020).
4	Additional Secretary to Government – Health and Family Welfare Department and Medical Education, has instructed all Deputy commissioners, to ensure, High pressure Oxygen supply, compressed air and Suction are uninterrupted for wards and ICU in respective COVID-19 facilities in Districts. (Ref. No. HFW 112 ACS 2020 Dated: 17.04.2020).
5	In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 183 people have been screened on 17.04.2020 and till on date 4236 people have been screened. 450 Fever Clinics of state, in total 2451 people have been screened on 17.04.2020 and till on date 58015 people have been screened.
6	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 27 persons in Institutions on 17.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 559 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.

7	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 961 sessions were held on 17.04.2020 and so far 41354 number of counseling
8	sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants. In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has lunched "Aarogya Setu" Mobile app on 09.04.2020. Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call 104 – Arogya Sahayavani, Health Helpline.
