Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **213 Countries / Territories including** India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 20th April 2020, Cumulatively 408 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 16 Deaths & 112 Discharges"

Out of remaining **280** cases, **278** COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman, P-176) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **2 in ICU** (P101 & P349).

18 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 19.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 20.04.2020, 5:00 PM.

Programmatic Updates

1	Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka has issued directions to all Departments, Deputy Commissioners, Superintendent of Police and other Heads of the Departments that "They shall continue to implement the measures presently in force in the State for containment of COVID-19 in the State till midnight of 21.04.2020" (Ref. No. RD 158 TNR 2020 Dated 19.04.2020).
2	In Order to prevent the further spread of COVID-19 & necessary actions towards the containment activity, the Commissioner, BBMP has declared 19 containment zones in the BBMP area (Ref. No. PSR (4) /PR/50/2020-2021 Dated 19.04.2020).
3	Home Secretary, Government of India has issued directions to all Chief Secretary, States / UTs to ensure smooth movement of the entire supply chain of essential goods, including by E-commerce during this COVID-19 containment and lockdown period. (Ref. No. RD 158 TNR 2020 Dated 19.04.2020)
4	Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has issued Standard Operating Protocols (SOP) for movement of Stranded Labour within the State / UT and directed State for its strict implementation. (Ref. No.40-3/2020-DM-I (A) Dated 19.04.2020).
5	In order to contain spread of COVID-19 and preventive measures to be adopted by State / UT, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India has issued additional precautionary measures (Ref. No.Z8015/17/2020-Estt.I Dated 19.04.2020).
6	ICMR, Department of Health Research, GOI has issued advisory to all COVID-19 Labs, that all labs should register on the website <u>https://covid19cc.nic.in/ICMR</u> which will provide credentials for uploading results using RATI app available on google play store (<u>https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=nic.hp.rati</u>). "Help documentation for registration and upload of the data is available on the website <u>https://covid19cc.nic.in/ICMR</u> " (Ref. D. O. No. VIR/4/2020/ECD-I (Vol .I) Dated 18.04.2020).
7	 In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 92 people have been screened on 19.04.2020 and till on date 4479 people have been screened. 451 Fever Clinics of State, in total 7232 people have been screened on 19.04.2020 and till on date 76020 people have been screened.
8	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 15 persons in Institutions on 19.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 596 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
9	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 486 sessions were held on 19.04.2020 and so far 42738 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.
