NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 06/04/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **209 countries** / **territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka state has strengthened all surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

On 05.04.2020, 22 individuals have been screened at Karwar port.

"As of 5:00 PM of 6th April 2020, cumulatively 163 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the state, it includes 4 deaths & 20 discharges"

Out of remaining cases 139, 136 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 3 *in ICU* (P43 on oxygen and P101 & P102 on Ventilators).

12 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 05.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 06.04.2020 5:00 PM.

Programmatic Updates

- Department of Health Research has notified 10 dedicated laboratories supported by ICMR for COVID-19, in Karnataka, the details are as below:

- Centre Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 25.03.2020 has published in their website, the revised guidelines for handling, treatment and disposal of waste generated during Treatment, Diagnostics and Quarantine of COVID-19 patients.
- In view of breaking the chain and containment of COVID-19, Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru has directed to all the managements not to allow any congregational prayers in the Masajid and the managements of the Qabrasthans (Muslim graveyards) / Darghas through out the state and to suspend the visit of public on the occasion of SHAB-E-BARAT on thursday, 9th April 2020.

No public shall be allowed to perform religious rituals in the Qabrasthans / Darghas and all the gates of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall be kept closed.

All managements of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall take necessary action on the above directions and all Waqf officers, District Waqf Advisory Committee in state shall adhere to the orders and directed to circulate the same and to ensure the order is followed scrupulously.

- 4 In **31** Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 142 people have been screened on 05.04.2020 and till on date 1981 people have been screened.
- Home Quarantine Enforcement squad have quarantined 15 persons in institutions on 05.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date **386** have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
- The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for mental health counseling of such patients and contacts 1,122 sessions were held on 05.04.2020 and so far 24,684 number of counseling sessions have been held.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 05.04.2020 calls 12,328 have been received and around 34,464 calls have outgone along with 91 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in home isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest government hospital or call 104 health helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
