CIRCULAR

Subject: Guidelines for 10 bedded Isolation ward on preparedness of COVID-19.

As you are aware, COVID-19 has been declared as public health emergency of international concern. It has now affected 75 countries including India. In this regard you are hereby instructed to maintain a 10 bedded isolation ward on preparedness of COVID-19 in your hospital. The hospital should follow the below mentioned guidelines:

Guidelines for 10 bedded Isolation Ward

- 1. Distance between each bed should be a minimum of 1 meter.
- 2. Separate wall or roof fall screen between each bed.
- 3. Good ventilators atleast 12 cycle / minute or 16 cycles of air / second / good cross ventilation.
- Separate medical equipments for each patient like thermometer, pulse oximeter, sthethoscope and necessary medicines (if not available, to be sterilized after each case).
- 5. Separate personal kits for each patient like sterilizers, tissue papers, soaps etc.,
- 6. Case sheet should be kept outside the ward.
- Always enter the ward with PPE. After use, it has to be discarded according to Bio-Medical Waste Management rules and packed properly.
- 8. All protocols of Isolation ward has to be followed.

Note: All District Surveillance Officers are instructed to confirm the provision of Isolation Ward at your district (Medical Colleges, District Hospitals, Major Hospitals, Taluka General Hospitals).
