ORDER

Vide orders read 1st, Covid Firstline Treatment Centres (CFLTCs) are to be established to contain possible surge of Covid-19. In order to ensure the safety of elderly and persons with comorbidity, Reverse Quarantine Facilities (RQFs) are also to be established.

2) In order to contain the spread, it is deemed necessary to identify and operationally ready CFLTCs with a minimum of 100 beds per panchayat and 50 beds per urban ward. As soon as an area is notified as Containment Zone, a 100 bedded CFLTC must be kept ready to admit patients in that area itself. Reverse quarantine facility also needs to be established.

3) In light of the above, following IAS officers are deputed to the respective Districts for assisting them in establishing CFLTCs and RQFs
