Kerala Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2, 3 & 4 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 (Central Act 3 of 1897), the Government of Kerala has issued regulations as Kerala Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020.for the strict compliance, for the containment management and control of COVID-19 21-3-2020 as part of endeavor to eliminate COVID-19 from the State.

Advisories

Any person with travel history to COVID19 affected countries or person with contact with such a traveler, whether they are having symptoms or not, must remain in home isolation. Do frequent hand washing with soap and water. Avoid social greetings by touching, like hugs or handshake. Don't touch your face, nose and eyes. Use handkerchief while coughing/ sneezing. Use masks, only if you are taking a care of a person with suspected COVID-19 infection, or if you have symptoms. Those who are wearing masks should know how to use and dispose it properly. N95 masks should not be worn by the public. It is advisable for all to use masks during the COVID 19 pandemic season.

WHO has declared the COVID-19 epidemic affecting **213** countries, areas or territories as a Pandemic. Considering the increase in number of cases, COVID 19 has been re-notified as a state specific disaster on 20.03.2020. Kerala state has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease in view of the same.

Home/Hospital Isolation

• 36667 persons are placed under surveillance, out of which 36335 are under home isolation and 332 are admitted in designated isolation facilities.

Sample Testing

• Till date 20252 samples of suspect cases have been sent for testing out of which 19449 came as negative.

Test Results

- Total confirmed cases under treatment till yesterday were **114**.
- 19 new cases have been declared positive today. 10 from Kannur, 4 from Palakkad, 3 from Kasaragod, and 1 each from Kollam and Malappuram have been declared positive.
- Test results of 16 persons have been declared negative. 7 from Kannur, 4 from Kasaragod (1 person under treatment in Kannur), 4 from Kozhikode (2 Kannur natives), 1 from Thiruvananthapuram have been declared negative.
- As of now **117** Positive cases are under treatment.
- 88 LSGDs as per GO (Rt) No. 740/2020/H&FWD dated 19-04-2020 and 86 LSGDs as per revised GO (Rt) No. 740/2020/H&FWD dated 20-04-2020 were notified as Hotspots in the state. Based on the report of 20-04-2020 by SDMA two more LSGDs from Kannur; Chembilode and Papiniseri are also declared as Hotspots as confirmed cases are reported from there.

Complimentary Activities

- COVID Care Centres have been established in all districts with a view to accommodate people who have been advised home isolation but have no residence in Kerala(e.g.: Tourists, people in transit etc). And to accommodate any person in home isolation but not following the home isolation guidelines. These centers will also accommodate the Keralite returning from various states in India.
- For providing psychosocial support, 1064 Personnel are working and have provided tele-counselling to 2,13,183 numbers of persons in quarantine/ isolation. In addition to this, psychosocial support calls are given to mentally ill patients, Children with special needs, Guest labourers& elderly people living alone. Tele-counselling is also given to alleviate stress of personnel working in

Corona Outbreak control activities. A total of 5,02,358 Tele-counselling calls have been given to all such categories till date. Coordination of Community Deaddiction is also being done.

- Home isolation ensured with the help of squads at LSG level including health staff, police and volunteers.
- Adequate infrastructure facilities have been ensured at all designated isolation facilities.
