ADVISORY REGARDING SWABBING OF SYMPTOMATIC INDIVIDUALS UNDERGOING RAPID ANTIGEN TEST FOR COVID-19.

The Indian Council for Medical Research (ICMR), has issued advisory that all **symptomatic** individuals found negative on Rapid Antigen Test shall undergo sequential testing by RTPCR.

It has been observed that retesting by RTPCR of symptomatic and rapid antigen test negative individuals needs to be improved in the state.

In this regard it is advised that:

- Two swabs are to be taken simultaneously at the time of swabbing of symptomatic individuals undergoing Rapid Antigen test .
- One sample should be used to perform the Rapid Antigen test.
- If the rapid antigen test is found to be negative on a symptomatic individual, the other swab should be definitely sent immediately for testing using RTPCR.
