E-pass facility for people stranded outside the state

Facility not to be extended in Indore, Bhopal and Ujjain district

The state government has decided to provide e-pass facility for the movement of citizens of M.P. stranded in other states as well as the citizens of other states stranded in Madhya Pradesh in number large due to the

lockdown. This facility will not be extended in Bhopal, Indore and Ujjain districts. In these districts, permission will be given in case of death in family, medical emergency or under special circumstances.

The people who are stranded under the lockdown in the districts want to go back by their own means of transport can submit their application at <u>http://mapit.gov.in/covid-19</u>. E-pass will be issued by the respective districts. Similarly, the people who are stuck outside the state and want to come to the state by their own means, they can also apply through this portal. The e-pass will be issued by the officer of the district in which they wish to come back. The process of issuing both e-passes will be in addition to the death of family members in the family and medical emergencies.

The In-charge of State Corona Control Room, Additional Chief Secretary Shri I.C.P. Keshri has written to all the Collector and Superintendent of Police stating that the facility of issuing e-passes will not be applicable in Indore, Ujjain, Bhopal. Apart from this, movement from the containment areas of the districts will also be restricted. Records of people coming to the state will be kept and their necessary health test will also be done.
