Three-tier health centres identified for treatment of Covid-19

The implementation of I.I.T.T. strategy has been started in the state on the initiative of Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan for Corona infection control. This strategy, based on four levels of identification, isolation, testing, and treatment, will enable rapid control in the affected areas.

Additional Chief Secretary Public Health and Family Welfare Shri

Mohammad Suleman informed that under the I.I.T.T. strategy, the first Corona infection affected / potential areas are being identified where people have come from outside or people suffering from respiratory or other related diseases are living in greater number. To isolate these areas, they are being marked as control (containment) areas. Here, essential materials will be supplied by government agencies, restricting the external traffic. All the people living in the control area will be tested and treatment will be given according to the symptoms.

Based on the symptoms and severity of Covid-19, three levels of care and treatment have been identified. People with minimum symptoms will be placed in Covid dedicated health centres and patients with more symptoms will be kept in Covid dedicated hospitals. Shri Suleman said that 112 rapid response teams and 154 mobile health teams are active in the state for quick action.
