Rs. One thousand will be given to each labourer stranded in other states: CM Shri Chouhan

The Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that Rs. One thousand for accommodation and food arrangement will be deposited in the accounts of each labourer of the state stranded in other states due to the lockdown. In addition, if needed more amount will be given to them. The Chief Minister said that seven senior officers have also been deployed to monitor these

arrangements in other states.

Shri Chouhan said that he had discussed with the Chief Ministers of other states to ensure arrangement of ration and accommodation for the labourers of Madhya Pradesh, who are stranded in their states due to the lockdown. He said that the MPs and MLAs of the state are being asked to send a list of such affected labourers in their area soon. As soon as lists come, we will come to know the names and transfer this amount to the accounts of those labourers.

Ration for labourers

The Chief Minister said that labourers have no work after the harvesting in the state. He said that he has directed the Collectors to ensure arrangement for accommodation and rations for these labourers. He also discussed with the public representatives as regard to the arrangement for the labourers.

Ration card holders to get free 2 months ration

The Chief Minister said that arrangements are being made to give 5 k.g. ration per person for free for two months from this month to ration card holders. One kilogram of pulses and wheat-rice will be given in it. In addition, ration arrangements are being made for those who do not have a ration card.
