- Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri Naveen Patnaik has said that sincerity and dedicated service of our front line COVID Warriors to make the life of people secure are beyond comparison. Their sacrifice is unlimited. Wishing early recovery of ailing COVID Warriors, Hon'ble Chief Minister said that we have to show our commitment and unity to the world in such a situation. Everybody has to be careful and self disciplined on his part to win the battle against COVID-19 and that will be the true respect to the COVID Warriors, he said.
- Ahead of Bahuda Jatra and associated rituals etc., Puri District Administration announced clamping of Curfew from 10PM of 30.6.2020 till 10PM of 2.7.2020. Curfew will be enforced in the entire district and no vehicular movement except essential services and medical urgency will be allowed. During the curfew all roads leading to Puri will be sealed.
- As per direction of Hon'ble Chief Minister, persons who have successfully completed institutional quarantine are being given incentive of Rs.2000/- each. A sum of Rs. 58,48,38,000/- has been paid so far. This amount is given from Chief Minister's Relief Fund.
- Odia brothers and sisters are returning to Odisha every day. 2048 Odia people have returned to Odisha today. So far 5,81,694 Odias have returned to Odisha.
- From 27th June morning to 28th June morning, 7 no of cases have been registered by the Police in the state for violation of different regulations and guidelines related to COVID-19 out of which 6 cases are for violation of lock down and 1 case for violation of Home Quarantine. 31 persons have been arrested so far.
