| OPD services | As per Government of India instructions on social distancing, and other infection control practices at workplaces and hospitals, efforts were made to reduce OPD services (by curtailing registration timings) from March 19, but the average attendance remained around 4000 patients per day (+4000-6000 attendants). On March 24, due to lockdown measures, non-emergency OPD services were curtailed to ensure all patients were screened for covid-19 before further evaluation and treatment. Emergency outpatient and inpatient services continue in all speciality departments (ENT, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, Dental, Medicine, Pulmonology, Dermatology, Surgery, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Radiation oncology, Orthopaedics, Anesthesiology and Critical Care, Emergency Medicine) and superspecialty departments (Cardiology, Cardiac Surgery, Neurology, Surgical Oncology, Medical Gastroenterology, Surgical Gastroenterology, Immunology, Plastic Surgery, Nephrology, Neonatology and Urology). All laboratory and imaging services are functional. Maintenance haemodialysis, cancer treatment and blood bank services are continuing uninterrupted. | | | |

| Covid Hospital block | A new 300-bed exclusive hospital block with intensive care units (with 36 ventilators, monitors) and 142 beds with piped oxygen supply has been created at the instruction of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. This facility is to serve as a referral facility for high-risk Covid- 19 patients requiring intensive multi-specialty care or ventilatory support. | | | |
