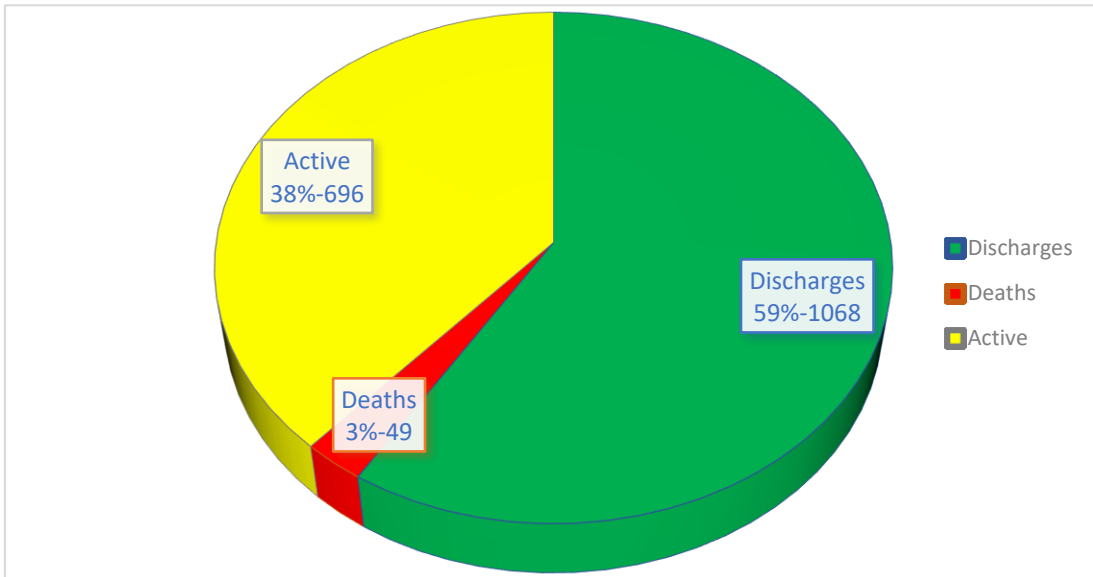

**MIGRANTS**

- Large number of migrants are entering the state from across the country.
- The Evacuees from other countries that are arriving at Hyderabad by designated flights are being screened at the airports and the symptomatic persons are tested for Covid-19.
- All migrants arriving by road and rail are being screened for symptoms at railway stations and at road border check posts.
- The asymptomatic migrants arriving in Telangana through various points of entry are quarantined at home and in government quarantine facilities.
- The symptomatic migrants are isolated and tested and for further course of action.
- The general public are requested to inform the local authorities in case they identify any new persons, migrants who have newly arrived in the towns and villages.

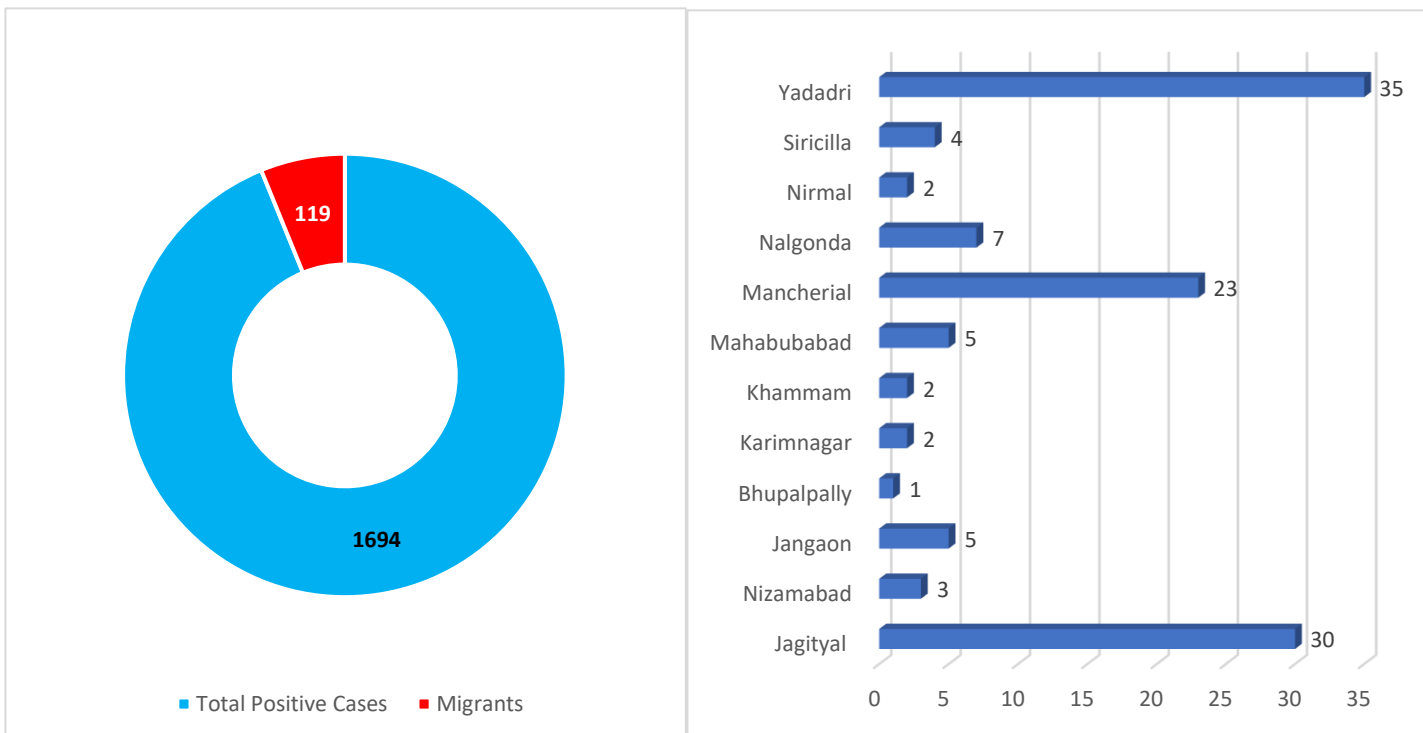
**FOREIGN RETURNEES POSITIVE TODAY**

## **SPECIAL ADVISORY IN VIEW OF RELAXATION OF LOCKDOWN**

The lockdown has been relaxed since the 16<sup>th</sup> May 2020. It is being observed that there is a lot of mobility and movement of people from all walks of life and of all age groups. There is a surge of positive cases since the past few days. In view of ensuring safety, the following guidelines are issued for strict compliance.

**Vulnerable Age Groups:** Less than 10yrs children and above 60yrs old people are to avoid going outdoors. They are to stay indoors.

**Use of Face Masks:** Please do not go out of the house without wearing masks. Face masks are the first line of defense against Covid-19

**Physical Distancing:** Maintaining a distance of more than 6ft between people is essential. The citizens who go out for purchasing groceries and other essentials are to maintain safe physical distance.

**Workspace:** The workspaces are to be provided with hand washing facility and sanitizer.

**Travel:** The citizens are requested to avoid unnecessary travel. In case it is avoidable, they shall ensure all safety measures- use face masks, frequent hand wash, use of sanitizer, safe physical distance etc.

**Seek Medical care:** In case of any Flu/ Influenza like symptoms such as cough, sore throat, running nose, fever, difficulty in breathing, body pains and headache, please report to the nearest government health facility and seek the required health services with out any delay.

**Morbidities:** People with morbidities like Hypertension, Diabetes, cardiac illness, Chronic kidney disease, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and any other chronic illness are requested to stay indoors and avoid any kind of travel.
