Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19 test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Four Hundred Seventy-One (471) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 17, Bageshwar– 00, Chamoli– 17, Champawat– 00, Dehradun– 145, Haridwar– 118, Nainital– 70, Pauri– 02, Pithoragarh– 62, Rudraprayag– 09, Tehri– 03, U.S. Nagar– 27 & Uttarkashi– 01).
- **Death:** Ten (10) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 55-year-old female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest & Acute Ischaemic Stroke.
 - (2) A 56-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Septic Shock.
 - (3) A 57-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Cardiac Arrest.
 - (4) A 63-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Stroke.
 - (5) A 48-year-old female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Sepsis.
 - (6) An 81-year-old male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest.
 - (7) A 49-year-old male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonia & Type 2 Respiratory Failure.
 - (8) A 70-year-old male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest.
 - (9) A 70-year-old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Septicemia & Shock
 - (10) A 48-year-old male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest.


