Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19 test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.





Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** One Thousand Thirteen (1013) patients discharged in different districts (Almora- 72, Bageshwar- 25, Chamoli- 56, Champawat- 32, Dehradun- 276, Haridwar- 48, Nainital- 150, Pauri- 74, Pithoragarh- 93, Rudraprayag- 51, Tehri- 62, U.S. Nagar- 69 & Uttarkashi- 05).
- **Death:** Thirteen (13) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - 1. A 72 year old Male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Respiratory Distress, Syndrome, Acute Coronary Syndrome, Septicemia & Shock.
 - 2. A 65 year old Female expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Kidney Injury & Acute Coronary Sydney.
 - 3. A 33 year old Female expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Ventricular Arrhythmia.
 - 4. A 76 year old Male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, COVID Pneumonia, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Sepsis & Septic Shock.
 - 5. A 61 year old Male expired from AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Severe COVID Pneumonia, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Multi Organ Dysfunction Syndrome & Acute Kidney Injury.
 - 6. A 77 year old Female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehardun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Septic Shock.
 - 7. A 89 year old Female expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Pneumonia, Sepsis & Shock.
 - 8. A 40 year old Female expired in Max Hospital due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Sepsis & Shock.
 - 9. A 63 year old Male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - 10. A 60 year old Female expired in Velmed Hospital, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonia, Respiratory Failure.
 - 11. A 76 year old Male expired in STGH Haldwani due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections & Bilateral Pneumonitis.
 - 12. A 81 year old Female expired in STGH Haldwani due to Acute CardioPulmonary Arrest & Severe Acute Respiratory Infections Bilateral Pneumonitis.
 - 13. A 83 year old Male expired in Neelkanth Hospital, Haldwani due to Bilateral Pneumonia, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Coronary Artery Disease & CerebroVascular Accident.
