

Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Five Hundred Fourty Seven (547) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 22, Bageshwar– 12, Chamoli– 13, Champawat– 00, Dehradun– 149, Haridwar– 40, Nainital– 129, Pauri– 48, Pithoragarh– 30, Rudraprayag– 13, Tehri– 21, U.S. Nagar– 00 & Uttarkashi– 70).
- **Death:** Eight (08) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is asbelow:
 - 1. A 84 year old Male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Refractory Cardiogenic Shock & Inferior Wall Myocardial Infarction.
 - 2. A 72 year old Female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehardun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Sepsis & Septic Shock.
 - 3. A 66 year old Male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehardun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonia, Coronary & Artery Disease.
 - 4. A 59 year old Female expired in Velmed Hospital, Dehardun due to Bilateral Pneumonia, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Lower Respiratory Tract Infection & Septic Shock.
 - 5. A 75 year old Female expired in Velmed Hospital, Dehardun due to Bilateral Pneumonia, Respiratory Failure & Shock.
 - 6. A 50 year old Male expired in HNB Base Hospital, Srinagar due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - 7. A 13 year old Female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Anemia, Thrombocytopenia, Bilateral Severe Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Respiratory Failure & Refractory Shock.
 - 8. A 50 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Shock.


