

Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Five Hundred Seventy Nine (579) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 19, Bageshwar– 00, Chamoli– 17, Champawat– 00, Dehradun– 168, Haridwar– 30, Nainital– 104, Pauri– 38, Pithoragarh– 73, Rudraprayag– 12, Tehri– 05, U.S. Nagar– 108 & Uttarkashi– 05).
- **Death:** Eleven (11) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - 1. A 68 year old Female expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Severe Sepsis with Septic Shock. COVID Pneumonia & Perforation Peritonitis.
 - 2. A 67 year old Female expired in Synergy Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun due to CardioRespiratory Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis & Respiratory Failure.
 - 3. A 80 year old Female expired in Kailash Hospital, Dehradun due to Acute Kidney Injury & Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - 4. A 57 year old Female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Acute Coronary Syndrome, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Bilateral Pneumonitis.
 - 5. A 72 year old Female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - 6. A 65 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections & Bilateral Pneumonitis.
 - 7. A 58 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Septicemia, Septic Shock & Uremic Encephalopathy.
 - 8. A 50 year old Male expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & COVID Pneumonia.
 - 9. A 60 year old Male expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Myocardial Infarction, COVID pneumonia & Coronary Artery Disease.
 - 10. A 68 year old Male expired in The Medicity Hospital, Rudrapur due to Bilateral Interstitial Pneumonia, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Severe Septic Shock, Acute Kidney Injury & Multiple Organ Dysfunction Syndrome.
 - 11. A 60 year old Female expired in Prayas Hospital Khatima, US Nagar due to Cardiac Arrest, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Sepsis.


