



Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Four Hundred Sixteen (416) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 00, Bageshwar– 12, Chamoli– 00, Champawat– 16, Dehradun– 174, Haridwar– 60, Nainital– 99, Pauri– 06, Pithoragarh– 23, Rudraprayag– 04, Tehri– 00, U.S. Nagar– 08 & Uttarkashi– 14).
- **Death:** Thirteen (13) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - 1. A 54 year old Male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Severe COVID Pneumonia.
 - 2. A 79 year old Male expired in Kailash Hospital, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonia & Coronary Artery Disease.
 - 3. A 87 year old Male expired in Kailash Hospital, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonia & Type 2 Respiratory Failure.
 - 4. A 65 year old Male expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonia & Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - 5. A 65 year old Female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest & Shock.
 - 6. A 63 year old Male expired in Max Hospita,l Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest with severe COVID.
 - 7. A 50 year old Female expired in Max Hospital, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonia & Refractory Shock.
 - 8. A 60 year old Male expired in Max Hospital Dehradun due to Refractory Hypoxia, Refractory Shock, Aspiration Pneumonia & Type 2 Respiratory Failure.
 - 9. A 70 year old Female expired from Himalayan Hospital Dehradun on 26 Dec 2020,due to Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - 10. A 75 year old Male expired in Jaya Maxwell Hospital Bahadrabad, Haridwar due to Cardiac Arrest.
 - 11. A 65 year old Female expired in Neelkanth Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest & Bilateral Pneumonitis.
 - 12. A 50 year old Female expired from CHC Gairsain, Chamoli due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure followed by Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - 13. A 72 year old Male expired in Distt. Uttarkashi. The Cause of Death is awaited from the District.


