Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **422** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Three Hundred Five (305) patients discharged in different districts (Almora—00, Bageshwar—00, Chamoli—104, Champawat—00, Dehradun—50, Haridwar—36, Nainital—14, Pauri—30, Pithoragarh—00, Rudraprayag—20, Tehri—02, U.S. Nagar—49 & Uttarkashi—00).
- **Death:** Six (06) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - 1. A 70 year old Male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Acute Kidney Injury & Sepsis.
 - 2. A 50 year old Male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Severe COVID.
 - 3. A 84 year old Female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehardun due to Bilateral Pneumonia with Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - 4. A 35 year old Female expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & COVID Pneumonia.
 - 5. A 70 year old Male expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to COVID Pneumonia.
 - 6. A 73 year old Male expired in Distt. Almora due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest & Bilateral Pneumonitis.
