Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **15** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **96** Health facilities

Public Health Action Taken

- Government has started psychiatric/ mental counselling facility from 104 Helpline service. The citizens who are in need may call at toll-free helpline 104.
- Government has introduced a new initiative for tele-medicine service through **e-Sanjeevani OPD** (online Portal for tele-consultation).
- To combat the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the state government has notified revised discharge policy for cured and treated COVID-19 patients as per the directions of GOI.

APPEAL

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who are contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state must observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house.

NOTE:

- Last night, after release of the Health update, 8.00 PM, 37 COVID-19 Positive cases from district Tehri (16), Haridwar (06), Pauri (13) and Dehradun (02) were reported at 11:45 PM.
- As per Health Bulletin dated 26.05.2020, 3.00 PM there were 10 Positive cases shown in district Nainital, whereas the actual number was 09 only, the 10th case was a repeat sample. Hence cumulative number of Positive cases in district Nainital are 135.
- 12 COVID-19 cases were cured/treated from District Udham Singh Nagar and 03 COVID-19 cases from District Nainital. These patients were admitted in Govt. Medical College Haldwani.

Description/ Travel History of Positive detected Patients:

- Dehradun: 01- Noida, 01- Contact of previously positive case, 01- Admitted in Govt. Doon Hospital (ICU)
- Haridwar : 06 Mumbai
- Tehri : 01- Delhi, 15- Maharashtra
- Pauri: 01 Noida, 12 Maharashtra
