Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Goverment has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.





Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- Treated & Cured: Five Hundred Five (505) patients discharged in different districts (Almora- 00, Bageshwar- 05, Chamoli- 47, Champawat- 00, Dehradun- 75, Haridwar- 21, Nainital- 119, Pauri- 76, Pithoragarh- 07, Rudraprayag- 131, Tehri- 24, U.S. Nagar- 00 & Uttarkashi- 00).
- **Death:** Five (05) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 52-year-old female expired in Synergy Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis with Sever Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome with Respiratory Failure.
 - (2) A 64-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to End-Stage Renal Disease with Pneumonitis, Sepsis & Metabolic Acidosis with Cardiac Arrest.
 - (3) A 62-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Pneumonia & Chronic Kidney Disease with Septicemia.
 - (4) A 78-year-old male expired in Military Hospital, Pithoragarh due Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Pneumonia.
 - (5) A 65-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Pneumonia, Sepsis Lower respiratory tract infection, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus.




Preventive measures

- 3. Hand wash by Soap and water up to 40 second must be followed.


APPEAL
