### Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Government has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

#### **Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:**

- **Treated & Cured:** Four Hundred Foruty-One (441) patients discharged in different districts (Almora—01, Bageshwar—01, Chamoli—65, Champawat—00, Dehradun—126, Haridwar—04, Nainital—142, Pauri—40, Pithoragarh—15, Rudraprayag—35, Tehri—03, U.S. Nagar—00 & Uttarkashi—09).
- **Death:** Nine (09) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
  - (1) A 66-year-old Male, expired from STH Haldwani due to COVID 19 pneumonia with T2DM, systematic hypertension, hypothyroidism.
  - (2) A 66-year-old Male, expired from STH Haldwani due to COVID 19 pneumonia/SARI, sever ARDS, type 1 Respiratory Failure.
  - (3) A 64 yrs Male, expired from STGH Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Bilateral Pneumonitis.
  - (4) A 53-year-old Male, expired from Jaya Maxwell Bahadarabad due to Cardiac Arrest.
  - (5) An 87-year-old Male, expired from STGH Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Kidney Injury, Shock.
  - (6) A 65-year-old Female, expired from HNB Base Hospital Srinagar due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
  - (7) A 65-year-old Male, expired from SMIH Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonia.
  - (8) A 70-year-old Male, expired in District Rudraprayag, cause of death is awaited.
  - (9) A 65-year-old Female, expired from SMIH Dehradun dur to Cardiopulmonary Arrest.









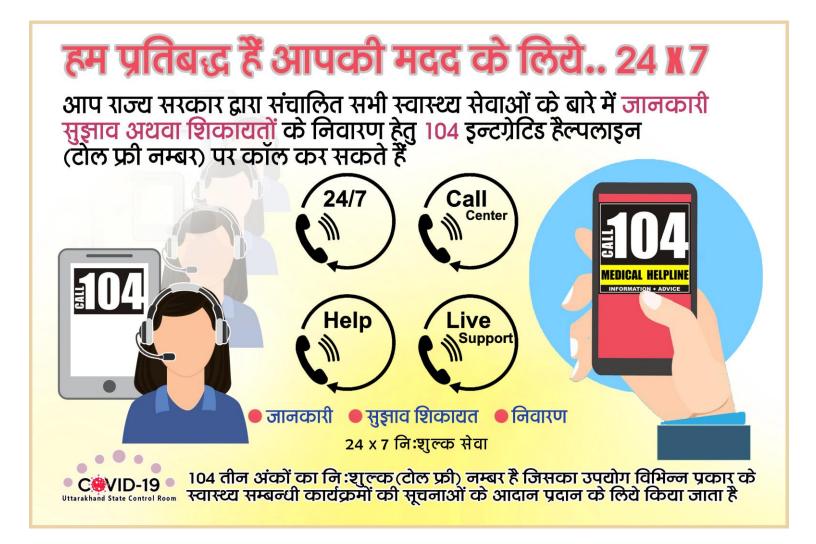
