Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Goverment has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.







Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- Treated & Cured: Four Hundred Fifty-Eight (458) patients discharged in different districts (Almora-03, Bageshwar- 21, Chamoli- 62, Champawat- 03, Dehradun- 167, Haridwar- 53, Nainital- 30, Pauri- 08, Pithoragarh-26, Rudraprayag-33, Tehri-01, U.S. Nagar-49 & Uttarkashi-02).
- **Death:** Eight (08) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 78-year-old female expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to COVID Related Bilateral Pneumonitis, CerebroVascular Accidient, Right Middle Cerebral Artery Infarction & Septicemia.
 - (2) A 63-year-old male expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.

- (3) A 71-year-old male expired in Neelkanth Multi-speciality Hospital Haldwani, Nainital due to Bilateral Pneumonia & Type 1 Respiratory Failure.
- (4) A 65-year-old male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Metabolic Acidosis.
- (5) A 36-year-old female expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Respiratory Failure Due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Severe Acute Respiratory Infection.
- (6) A 48-year-old male expired in HNB Base Hospital, Srinagar due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Cardiopulmonary Arrest & Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
- (7) A 47-year-old male expired in HNB Base Hospital, Srinagar due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Cardiopulmonary Arrest & Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
- A 62-year-old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Acute (8) Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 2 Respiratory Failure, Septicemia & Shock.




Preventive measures
