Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Government has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Two Hundred Fifty-One (251) patients discharged in different districts (Almora—01, Bageshwar—01, Chamoli—26, Champawat—00, Dehradun—115, Haridwar—15, Nainital—07, Pauri—01, Pithoragarh—00, Rudraprayag—52, Tehri—11, U.S. Nagar—00 & Uttarkashi—22).
- **Death:** Nine (09) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 67-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 2 Respiratory Failure, Acute Kidney Injury & Sepsis.
 - (2) A 49-year-old female expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Metabolic Acidosis & Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - (3) A 66-year-old female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Shock.
 - (4) A 78-year-old female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Shock.
 - (5) A 52-year-old female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Rest Distress Syndrome, Tye 1,2 Respiratory Failure & Respiratory Acidosis.
 - (6) A 61-year-old female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Septicemia & Shock.
 - (7) An 83-year-old female expired in HNB Base Hospital, Srinagar due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - (8) A 61-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Refractory Septic Shock, Multiple Organ Dysfunction Syndrome, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, COVID Pneumonia.
 - (9) A 49-year-old female expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Severe Metabolic Acidosis, CardioRespiratory Arrest.










