Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19 test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.





Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Three Hundred Seventeen (317) patients discharged in different districts (Almora–15, Bageshwar–13, Chamoli–05, Champawat–01, Dehradun–132, Haridwar–19, Nainital–19, Pauri–12, Pithoragarh–03, Rudraprayag–23, Tehri–04, U.S. Nagar–62 & Uttarkashi–09).
- **Death:** Eleven (11) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 60-year-old Female expired from Kailash Hospital Dehradun due to Cardio-Respiratory Arrest.
 - (2) An 80-year-old Male expired from GDMC Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Acute Coronary Syndrome, Sepsis.
 - (3) A 71-year-old Male expired from GDMC Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Metabolic Acidosis, Septic Shock.
 - (4) A 57-year-old Male expired from Himalayan Hospital Dehradun due to Severe COVID, Cardiac Arrest.
 - (5) A 27-year-old Male expired from Himalayan Hospital Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Cardiopulmonary Arrest.
 - (6) A 42-year-old male expired in DH, Pithoragarh due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Severe Acute Respiratory Infection
 - (7) A 56-year-old Female expired from STGH Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - (8) A 71-year-old Male expired from STGH Haldwani due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Septicemia, Shock.
 - (9) A 77-year-old Male expired from SMIH Dehradun due to Cardiac Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome.
 - (10) A 60-year-old Female expired from AIIMS Rishikesh due to Cardiogenic Shock, Severe COVID Pneumonia, Acute Coronary Syndrome.
 - (11) A 67-year-old Male expired from SMIH Dehradun due to Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis.










