
उत्तरः पहले से संक्रमित होने के बाबजूद वैक्सीन की पूरी खुराक लेना आवश्यक है क्योंकि यह

#### Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized 38 dedicated COVID Hospitals and 422 COVID Care Centres (CCC).

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced Home Isolation strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

#### **Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:**

- **Treated & Cured:** Three Hundred Three (303) patients discharged in different districts (Almora—01, Bageshwar—01, Chamoli—00, Champawat—01, Dehradun—111, Haridwar—00, Nainital—103, Pauri—08, Pithoragarh—51, Rudraprayag—11, Tehri—01, U.S. Nagar—00 & Uttarkashi—15).
- **Death:** Five (05) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
  - 1. A 67 year old Male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Septic Shock, Multiple Organ Dysfunction Syndrome, Disseminated Intravascular Coagulation & COVID Pneumonia.
  - 2. A 82 year old Male expired in Max Hospital, Dehradun Due to Refractory Shock, acute Coronary Syndrome, Atrial Fibrillation & COVID Pneumonia.
  - 3. A 47 year old Male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonia, Acute Kidney Injury & Septic Shock.
  - 4. A 65 year old Male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden Cardiopulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Septicemia & Shock.
  - 5. A 59 year old Male expired in JLN Distt. Hospital Rudrapur (US Nagar) due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Bilateral Basal Pneumonitis.


