### Situation Update, Uttarakhand:Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- 1- The Government has issued directions to all District Magistrates to ensure the promotion of 'Aarogya Setu' app among citizen of the state so as to make the citizens aware about COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2- Directions has been given to all Chief Medical Officers to ensure psychiatrist counselling to passengers/ people quarantined in identified quarantine facilities.
- 3- An advisory has been issued regarding not to consume and spit smokeless tobacco in public. As per advisory chewing smokeless tobacco products, pan masala and areca nut (supari) increases the production of saliva followed by a very strong urge to spit. Spitting in public places could enhance the spread of COVID-19 virus.
- 4- Comprehensive guidelines for dialysis with reference to COVID-19 have been issued by the Government. As per guideline the patients who do not have private vehicles shall be facilitated by 108 ambulance service. This will also apply to the physical challenged patients.
- 5- The Government has issued directions to provide masks, sanitizers, gloves and other consumables to all doctors, paramedics working in hospitals other than dedicated COVID-19 facilities/ hospitals.
- 6- Regular messages on Do's & Don'ts during lock down period are released for public awareness through print, electronic and social media. FM Radio and Community Radio are widely used.

Uttarakhand government launched a Mobile App "Uttarakhand COVID-19 Tracking System" as a platform for people to report and self-declare, if they are suspecting COVID-19 signs and symptoms. ## **APPEAL**

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from foreign travel) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house. If a person found/reported to be not following home quarantine as guideline, he/she will be put under institutional/facility quarantine. In case of any health emergency, assistance due to lockdown they may call state control room number 0135-2609500/helpline number 104/District control room numbers (Annexed) for assistance.

#### **Preventive measures:**

- 1- Home quarantine of all asymptomatic travelers for next 28 days after returning from COVID-19 affected countries.
- 2- Travelers' and their family members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene. Cover your face while coughing or sneezing, wash hands frequently and avoid handshakes.
- 3- Travelers, who have come from COVID-19 affected countries, must report to district/block health authorities immediately, if they develop any symptoms like fever, cough, cold or difficulty in breathing. Helpline/war room no. is 01352609500/104.
- 4- Indian citizens are advised to refrain from non-essential travel to COVID-19 affected countries.
- 5- Hospital isolation of all symptomatic travelers if they have returned from any of COVID-19 affected countries.
- 6- Frequent hand washing especially after touching anybody secretions like saliva or nasal secretions.
