## **Salient Features:**

- Rate of Doubling of positive cases in the state has been 28 days for past week (19th April to 25th of April 2020).
- Sample testing for COVID-19 per million populations for the state has been 455.
- Out of total samples tested only 1% sample turned Positive for COVID-19, which is less than the national average (3.62%).

### Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

#### **Public Health Action Taken**

- 1- To combat the ongoing outbreak of COVID-19, the government has issued directions to earmark 3-tire health facilities for COVID-19 patients.
- 2- The Government has issued directions to all District Magistrates to ensure the promotion of 'Aarogya Setu' app among citizen of the state so as to make the citizens aware about COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3- Directions has been given to all Chief Medical Officers to ensure psychiatrist counselling to passengers/ people quarantined in identified quarantine facilities.







#### **APPEAL**

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house. **Preventive measures:** 

- 1- All citizens must wear masks whenever venturing outside of their homes.
- 2- Facility quarantine of all asymptomatic travelers for next 28 days after returning from outside Uttarakhand.
- 3- Travelers' and their family members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene. Cover your face while coughing or sneezing, wash hands frequently and avoid handshakes.
- 4- Travelers, who have come from COVID-19 affected regions, must report to district/block health authorities immediately, if they develop any symptoms like fever, cough, cold or difficulty in breathing. Helpline/war room no. is 01352609500/104.
