Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

Public Health Action Taken

- Government has started psychiatric/ mental counselling facility from 104 Helpline service. Now onwards the citizens who are in need may call at toll-free helpline 104.
- To combat the COVID-19 pandemic the government has fast tracked recruitment of doctors, In this context, 107 posts of faculty for medical colleges have been advertised today.
- Government has introduced a new initiative for tele-medicine service through eSanjeevani OPD (online Portal for tele-consultation).

Note

Six COVID-19 cases from **Dehradun District** have been **treated and recovered**. **Five** treated patients are from **Doon Medical College** and **One** from **AIIMS Rishikesh**.

APPEAL

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house.

Preventive measures

- 1. All citizens must wear masks whenever venturing outside of their homes.
- 2. Facility quarantine of all asymptomatic travelers for next 28 days after returning from outside Uttarakhand.
- 3. Travelers' and their family members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene.
